

The Issue

- (Foothill-De Anza Community College Foundation)
 manages dozens of scholarships with unique
 eligibility requirements and does not have dedicated
 staff for this department
- Students miss deadlines, don't hear about opportunities, or find applications time-consuming, confusing, or repetitive
- Money that could help students is left unclaimed and could disappear next year



PROPOSED SOLUTION



- AI Chatbot to guide students through the application
- Custom knowledge base of scholarships and their information
- Uses RAG to search of the scholarships and match them with students



Market Application
